The following information is being provided by the Occupational Licensing Service as a guideline to determine the type of work that can be performed by persons who do not have a state license in the electrical, mechanical, or plumbing trade.

Below is work that can be done without a state electrical license:

ELECTRICAL

Replace single pole switches

Replace receptacle (same type, size and style)

Replace light sockets

Replace lamps

Replace plug-in breakers (with breakers of same amperage)

Replace fuses (same type, size and style)

Replace device covers

Replace motors (same type, size and style)

Work is limited to: Disconnecting and reconnecting devices and utilization equipment (same type, size and style): and maintenance of existing systems—work cannot be altered, extended or loads added to existing system.

MECHANICAL

Replacement of fuses and air filters

Lubrication of equipment

Cleaning of air supply and air return ducts, as long as the blower assembly and cooling coils are not removed

Thermostat calibration or replacement (residential only)

Routine maintenance as outlined in the owner's operation instructions.

PLUMBING

Minor repairs consisting of repairing or replacing faucets Minor repairs of working parts of plumbing fixtures
