DISCUSS AND CONSIDER PARKING SURROUNDING THE NEW SAPULPA PUBLIC SCHOOLS ADMINISTRATION BUILDING LOCATED AT 500 EAST LEE.

According to Police Chief Rumsey, Lee Street is 48' wide – it will not accommodate a long truck bed. There needs to be a 7' setback to accommodate diagonal parking. Currently there are 27-28 parking slots with 2 slots being reserved for handicap. The city obtained 2 quotes to restripe the parking slots; \$28,000 was the lowest of the quotes. Councilor Henderson does not think the city should pay for any restriping of parking slots. The school should have included this item in their last bond issue. Motion made by Councilor Henderson to deny any additional parking on Lee Street. 2nd by Councilor Rollings. Vote 4-0
