The SUP is coextensive in term with Applicant's current license from the OMMA for a Marijuana Processor and shall expire automatically upon the expiration, revocation or cancelation of said license.
- 2. The applicant shall submit a security plan for the location and shall contain the following:
 - a. Security surveillance cameras installed to monitor all entrances, along with the interior and exterior of the premises.
 - b. Alarm system which is professionally monitored and operated twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week.
 - c. A locking safe permanently affixed to the premises that shall store all marijuana and cash remaining in the facility overnight.
 - d. All marijuana in whatever form stored at the premises shall be kept in a secure manner and shall not be visible from outside the premises.
 - e. All of the security recordings shall be preserved for at least seven (7) days by the permit holder.
- 3. Sign Restrictions: No pictures, photographs, drawings or other depictions of marijuana or marijuana paraphernalia shall appear on the outside of the premises nor be visible outside of the premises. The words "Marijuana", "cannabis" and any other words used or intended to convey the presence or availability of marijuana shall not appear on the outside of the premises nor be visible from outside the premises.
- 4. All necessary building, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical, sign permits must be obtained.
- 5. The owner and operator of the facility shall use lawful methods in controlling waste or by-products from any allowed activities under the license.
- 6. The marijuana processor facilities must be constructed in such a manner that the processing cannot be seen by the public from the public right of way or adjoining lots.
- 7. The marijuana processor facilities shall my located within an entirely enclosed and secured structure.
- 8. The Applicant's activities must be in compliance with all applicable state and local laws and regulations.
- 9. All processor facilities must be properly vented so as not create humidity, mold or other related problems.
- 10. All marijuana processor facilities shall be conducted in a manner that does not constitute a public nuisance. A public nuisance may be deemed to exist if processing marijuana produces light, glare, heat, noise, odor or vibration that is detrimental to public health, safety or welfare or interferes with the reasonable enjoyment of life and property.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING THE ZONING CODE TO THE SAPULPA CITY CODE, APPENDIX H, ARTICLE 1, TO PROVIDE FOR A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS OF THIS ORDINANCE ARE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE, THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Sapulpa City Code, Appendix H, Article 1, is hereby repealed, amended, and replaced to read in its entirety, as follows:

"ARTICLE 1 CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

- 100 Membership
- 110 Election
- 120 Qualifications
- 130 Terms
- 140 Compensation
- 150 Rules and Procedures
- 160 Duties
- 170 Removal from Commission Membership
- 180 Reserved

SECTION 100 MEMBERSHIP

That the membership of the City Planning Commission of the City of Sapulpa shall be and the same is hereby set at seven (7) members. One member of the City Council of the City of Sapulpa shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve as one of the members of said Commission, and one resident at large of the City of Sapulpa shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve as one of the members of said Commission.

SECTION 110 ELECTION

Five (5) members of said Commission shall each be nominated by a member of the City Council. Said nomination shall be seconded by a member of the City Council and said nominee's name shall then be put to a vote of the City Council. Said nominee must be appointed to membership in said Commission by a majority vote of the City Council.

SECTION 120 QUALIFICATIONS

Each member of said Commission shall be a resident of the City of Sapulpa; a qualified and registered voter therein; a taxpayer; and a person of good character. At no time shall more than one (1) resident of any ward serve as a member upon said Commission, except as to

the City Council member and the resident at large who are each appointed to serve by the Mayor.

SECTION 130 TERMS

- A. On the first appointment of full membership, the members shall be appointed to serve terms as follows:
 - 1. Each member appointed from Wards 1, 3, and 5, and the member appointed by the Mayor from the City Council, shall serve for a term of two (2) years; and
 - 2. Each member appointed from Wards 2 and 4, and the member appointed by the Mayor from the City at large, shall serve for a term of three (3) years; and
 - 3. Members appointed to all posts thereafter, shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years.
- B. Each member appointed shall serve until his or her qualified successor is appointed. In the event of a member vacating or being removed from said appointment, the City Council and/or Mayor shall appoint a replacement in the same manner as provided for the initial appointment of said member and said replacement member shall serve only the unexpired term of the member being replaced.

SECTION 140 COMPENSATION

All members shall serve without pay. No member of said Commission shall receive any item, money or thing of material value for his or her services as a member of said Commission.

SECTION 150 RULES AND PROCEDURES

The members of said City Council shall adopt the rules and regulations under and by which said Commission shall function. The Commission shall determine and elect its officers and prescribe such officer's duties. Further, said Commission shall determine all orders of business before said Commission and shall set and determine dates and places of such meetings, both regular and special, as they may deem necessary.

SECTION 160 DUTIES

The City Planning Commission of the City of Sapulpa shall be responsible for the administration of the Planning and Zoning Ordinances of the City of Sapulpa and shall have all powers and functions as provided in the Oklahoma Statutes, relating to City Planning Commissions.

SECTION 170 REMOVAL FROM COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

Any Commission member, upon written charges and after public hearing, may be removed by the City Council for any one of the following causes:

- A. Failure to attend three (3) consecutive regular or special meetings, or failure to attend two-thirds (2/3) of the regular or special meetings held during any six (6) month period; or
- B. Actions and conduct unbecoming to a public official of the City of Sapulpa; or
- C. Repeated acts and conduct detrimental to the peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Sapulpa.

SECTION 180 RESERVED"

- **Section 2.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of conflict only.
- **Section 3.** If any part or parts of this ordinance are held invalid or ineffective, the remaining portions shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 4.** Effective Date. The rates reflected in this ordinance shall be in effect from and after July 1, 2019.
- **Section 5. EMERGENCY.** Being immediately necessary that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
